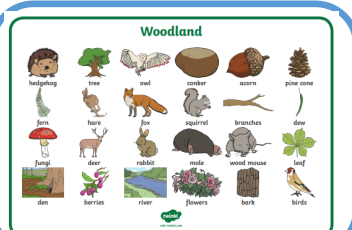


I wonder, what's happening all around us?

This half term, we are going to be exploring everything around us. We will venture outside and think about what changes we can see and feel; making use of our senses. We will apply this understanding to learning about the different seasons. From here, we will move on to learning about the woodlands and the types of animals that live here, focusing more specifically on bears. We will then start thinking about how everyone around us is preparing for a special celebration: Christmas! We will learn about the Nativity story and why this is important to Christians around the world.

Key Vocabulary

Seasons	Each of the four divisions of the year (spring, summer, autumn, and winter) marked by particular weather patterns and daylight hours.
Woodland	Land covered with trees.
Bear	A large, heavy mammal that walks on the soles of its feet, having thick fur and a very short tail. Different types include: brown, grizzly, polar and black bear.
Habitat	The natural home or environment of an animal or plant.
Nativity	The story of the birth of Jesus.
Wise Men	Noble pilgrims who followed a star to see baby Jesus.
Shepherd	A person who tends and rears sheep.
