I wonder, how do things grow?



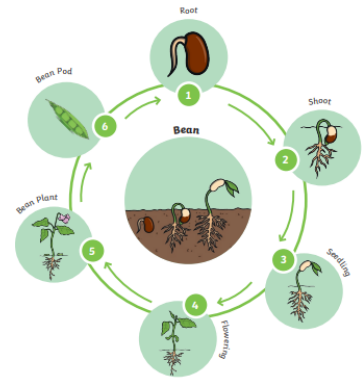
This half term, we are going to be exploring the natural world around us. We are going to describe what we can see, hear and feel whilst outside. We are going to link this to what we know about the changing seasons.

We are also going to explore how we can keep our bodies healthy to help us to grow.

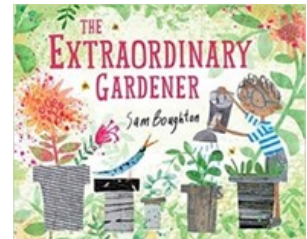
## Key Vocabulary

Seasons	Each of the four divisions of the year (spring, summer, autumn, and winter) marked by particular weather patterns and daylight hours,
Spring	The season after winter and before summer, in which vegetation be-
Shoot	The new growth from seed germination that grows upward is a shoot
Root	The part of a plant that grows underground.
Stem	The thin, upright part of a plant where the leaves and flower grows.
Pod	The seed vessel of a plant.
Growing	Natural development by increasing in size and changing physically.
