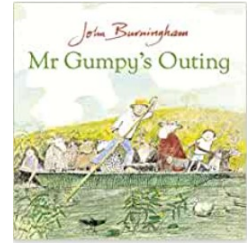


I wonder, how do we get there?

This half term, we are going to be exploring different ways to travel around the world. We will look at how transport has developed over time and the different mechanisms needed to travel through sea, air and on land.

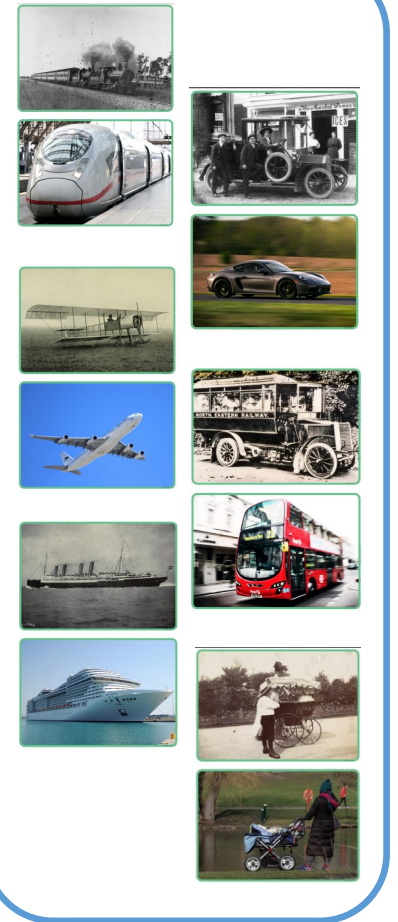
We will also explore some of the famous people who either invented these methods of transport, or did wonderful things with them.

Train	A series of connected railway carriages moved by a locomotive.
Boat	A small vessel for travelling over water, propelled by oars, sails or an engine.
Aeroplane	A powered flying vehicle with fixed wings.
Vehicle	A thing used for transporting people or goods.
