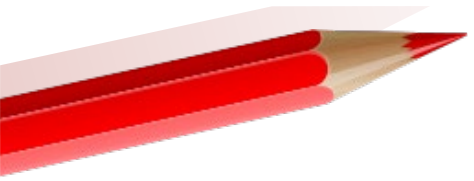

Our Trust




- We are part of the Diocese of Chelmsford Vine Schools Trust

 - One form entry school - we know you and your child well
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
Transition Arrangements

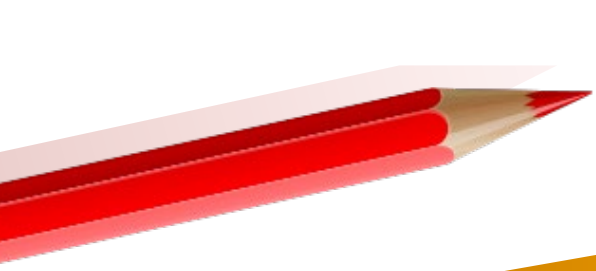


- Applications open on 6th November 2023 via Essex Local Authority
- Applications close on 13th January 2024
- National offer day is 16th April 2024
- If your child is successful in being offered a place we will write to you and inform you of important dates about transition
- If your child attends another nursery, we will arrange to visit their nursery and speak to their key worker. We may arrange a home visit if your child is not already in nursery
- You will be invited to stay and play sessions where you will get to know our EYFS team and they will find out about your child
- Whole school transition day – new reception children have a morning or afternoon session with their new friends and teacher.
